Finished Placemat: 12 ¾" x 18"

Featuring Lady Bird fabric by Crystal Manning for Moda Fabrics.

MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS		
Prints	1 Moda Charm Pack	Makes 2 Placemats
Binding	1/3 yard	
Backing & Batting	1/2 yard	

Pattern is based on 42" of usable fabric width.

BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all directions before beginning.
- All seam allowances are 1/4".
- (RST) is the abbreviation for Right Sides Together.
- (WOF) is the abbreviation for Width Of Fabric.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

FROM THE CHARM PACK:

- □ **(50)** 4 ½" x 2 ¼" rectangle
- □ **(20)** 2 ½" x 2 ¼" rectangle

FROM THE BACKING FABRIC:

□ (2) 17" x 22" (Includes overage for quilting).

FROM THE BATTING:

□ (2) 17" x 22" (Includes overage for quilting).

FROM THE BINDING FABRIC:

□ **(4)** 2 ¼ " x WOF strips

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Press all seam allowances open.

- **1.** Organize the **(25)** $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " and **(10)** $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles into 10 rows as shown in a brick laying format.
- **2.** Sew the short ends of the rectangles together (RST) forming 10 vertical rows. Each row should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $2 \frac{1}{4}$ ".
- **3.** Sew the vertical rows together to complete one placemat. Each placemat should measure $18" \times 12 \frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished. Repeat steps (1 3) for second placemat.

FINISHING

- **4.** Sandwich the placemat tops with batting and backing. Baste layers together using your preferred method.
- 5. Quilt as desired.
- **6.** Bind placemat using **(4)** 2 ¼" x WOF strips using your preferred method.
