

Dresden Fan 52" x 60"

*These instructions are to be used with the
Dresden Plate Quilts pattern by Prairie Point.*

Cut strips of fabric 6" wide.

(Cut fabric strips 6" x 21" or width of fabric. Or just cut your scraps into 6" widths.)

Referring to the pattern *Construction* directions, cut out 150 Dresden wedges. Follow instructions for creating the finished wedges. See Baby instruction sheet.

Sew five of the wedges together to make a fan.

Continuing to follow instructions, place a fan on a 8½" background square. You need 30 background squares to make this size quilt.

To make the center of the fan (corner) use the template below. It has a ¼" seam allowance on the straight sides. If you are turning under the curved edge, add seam allowance to the curved edge. If doing fusible applique, then cut pieces the size of the template.

Using your favorite applique method, stitch the fan and the center.

Lay out blocks according to picture, or any way you'd like. Sew into rows, then join rows.

Add inner border and outer border.

Background: 2-1/8 yards

Inner border: 1/3 yard Cut 5 or 6 strips 1½" x WOF

Outer border: 1 yard Cut 6 strips 5½" x WOF

Binding: ½ yard

Corner quarter circle: 1/8 yard or scrap of fabric
